

CMS/CHS ICU Program Overview

ICU

All students are expected to turn in their homework at CMS/CHS. A centralized location for staff to track missing work is set up (the list) and will be utilized on a daily basis to run the ICU Program. If a student is on the list they can be required to work on missing school work during the following intervention times: 1) Before school from 8:00-8:20, 2) During the students lunch period, 3) During the 8th Period ICU time, 4) after school from 3:25-4:00 p.m. (students will not be allowed to participate in extra curricular practices until after 4:00 p.m. if missing assignments). Staff will contact parents when the student is required to stay after school.

Expectations for Staff:

- The list needs to be updated on a daily basis. Staff need to ensure that we keep an accurate record of what a student is missing.
- If a student is going to stay after school or is needed before school – Staff will be required to contact the parent of that student.

Expectations of Students:

- They are to utilize the ICU period for making up any and all work that they are missing.
- If they are completely caught up with everything they are to read for AR.
- If they are assigned an intervention time before or after school they are expected to attend.
- If out for an activity (fine arts or athletics) and are on the list they are not allowed to practice after school until 4:00 p.m. They are to be with the teacher who they are missing work for getting caught up.

8th Period ICU

Students will report to their ICU teacher every day where attendance will be taken and the list will be viewed. All students who are missing school work will be required to work on those assignments that they are missing. Students who are not on the list will read AR. (Exception: 12th Grade students not on the list may leave after they have checked in for attendance and that their ICU teacher has verified they are not on the list) No student will be allowed to leave their ICU classroom to go to another teacher without the following:

- 1) A note from that particular teacher
- 2) A phone call involving the ICU teacher and the classroom teacher or
- 3) An email involving the ICU teacher and the other classroom teacher

Hall sweeps will take place during the 8th period by Admin – so during that period all students out of the classroom will have to have a pass.

Latework

Staff will accept late work throughout the semester.

You may dock for late work after 1 week of an assignment not being turned in. (1 letter grade per week).

You may not dock any lower more than 27% off a paper due to a late grade.

Tests and Quizzes

Students who score below a 50% are required to make up any test or quiz on a time set up by the classroom teacher. (ICU intervention time). An alternative version of the test will be given. Students must retake the exam until they score above a 50%.

Students may retake a test or quiz if they have a score above a passing grade as well. In this case the score would be averaged between the two tests. Students who pass an exam may only retake it one time.
